## ABOUT COMMUNITY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

The Mission of Community Behavioral Health Addictions program is to provide high quality comprehensive chemical dependency and mental health treatment services with a public health approach of reducing morbidity and mortality risk factors. In all our activities, the goal is to be helpful, compassionate, and responsive to the needs of those we serve.

The Addictions Program was founded to provide alcohol and drug users and their families services to help overcome the problems resulting from their substance abuse. At CBH this is accomplished through the use of core programs which are appropriate for different degrees of severity of the disease. Community Behavioral Health serves adults 18 and above suffering from addiction problems living on the Eastern Shore.

### CBH Offers

- Comprehensive treatment approach including the use of Suboxone/ Vivitrol combined with psychosocial counseling and education.
- Transitions offer Suboxone & Vivitrol in coordination with treatment services.

## What is Suboxone & Vivitrol?

Suboxone is a medication used as an adjunct to treat individuals with opioid addiction, with the intent of improving treatment outcomes. This medication is not the treatment for the disease of addiction, but rather decreases relapse rates and improves cognitive function so treatment can be more effective

VIVITROL is a prescription injectable medicine used to:

- Treat alcohol dependence. You should stop drinking before starting VIVITROL.
- Prevent relapse to opioid dependence after opioid detox. You must stop taking opioids or other opioid-containing medications before starting VIVITROL.
